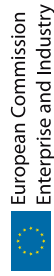

## Getting to LEARNTEC

### Venue

Karlsruhe Trade Fair Center/**Hall 1, Stand E 21**  
Messeallee 1  
76287 Rheinstetten, Germany

Karlsruhe is easily accessible by car, air or rail. It is also ideally linked to the public transportation system. You can reach the trade fairgrounds easily by S-Bahn or really take it easy: during many events there is a shuttle service – the Messe-Express – between the main station and the Trade Fair Center.

### By car

- From the **A5** Autobahn: Leave the Autobahn at junction 48, „Karlsruhe-Süd“. Take the B3 towards „Rheinstetten“. First exit onto the L566/L606 towards „Rheinstetten-Forchheim“. Take the B36 towards „Karlsruhe“. The New Exhibition Centre is 2 km (1.25 miles) along the road.
- From the **A65** Autobahn: The A65 merges with the B10. Leave the B10 at junction 8 and follow signs to „Messe“. The road name for satellite navigation systems is Leichtsandstraße (on some systems Leichtsandstrasse) in the Karlsruhe district of Rheinstetten.

### By plane

Karlsruhe/Baden-Baden (a drive of approx. 30 minutes) and other major international airports such as Frankfurt, Stuttgart and Strasbourg (a 50–60 minute drive).

### By tram

From the city centre, the S2 tram goes right past the Messe (New Exhibition Centre). The stop for the Exhibition Centre is „Leichtsandstraße“, where a walkway links the tram stop to the Exhibition Centre.
